

# 2017 PAPNM SPRING Paintout & Show

## Scheduled Paintout Locations

### Jemez, 4/28/17 – 5/4/17

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- May get packets and panels stamped at Jemez Fine Art Gallery, Jemez Springs, 11-5 except Tues (otherwise see scheduled location ea day).
- CAUTION: observe all posted speed limits, and watch for animals and pedestrians on roadways.
- NO PHOTOS OR PAINTING on Jemez reservation from 2 to 8mm Hwy 4, and to 3mm Hwy 290.
- These are **optional, scheduled** locations for each day. Participants may elect to paint in other locations, if not restricted. Note that some locations are indicated for panel stamping \*.
- **Some sites in red can only be used for painting on the indicated days, with special individual permission required to complete a painting on subsequent days. Any guest must accompany the registered participant in these restricted areas.**

#### KEY:

- \*: Panels stamped at 8 am each day at the optional, scheduled Paintout location
- **Red: restricted areas or available by permission.**
- Facilities: F -food available, eatery, CS-convenience store, G-gas station, [RR] outdoor rest room, RR-indoor rest room
- Painting: v-vistas, m-mesas, c-canyons, r-rocks, s-stream, p-pasture/meadow

"mi" is number of miles from beginning of hwy (also the mile marker)

#### **Friday, April 28: San Ysidro** at junction of Highways 550 and 4 <sup>G,CS,F,[RR],RR</sup>

- **\*San Ysidro Church** parking lot <sup>v,m,c</sup>, historic church, 1 mi Hwy 4
- **CWW Feed Store** <sup>[RR],F</sup>, livestock, corrals, tractors, tack, arena

- **San Ysidro Lane**<sup>RR; v,m,c,p</sup>, horses, tractors, adobe homes, 1 mi Hwy 4
- Perea Nature Trail<sup>v,m,s</sup>, wetland, 22 mi Hwy 550
- Hiking Trails BLM Area<sup>v,m,c,r</sup> - White Mesa view, 25 mi Hwy 550

Cabezon Road and Ojito area recommended for high clearance or 4WD vehicles.

**Saturday, April 29: Jemez Pueblo at 7413 Hwy 4**<sup>CS,G,F,[RR],RR;v,m,c,r, field house</sup>

- **\*Walatowa Visitor Center** – 7.7 mi Hwy 4-painting all day and catered Luncheon with PAPNM registration, 11-2pm
- **Red Rocks trail area** has cliffs, canyons, arroyo, mesas, junipers

**Sunday morning, April 30: Ponderosa, Hwy 290**

- **\*Santo Toribio Church**<sup>v,m,c</sup>, historic church (park up hill @church), 4.5 mi [directions](#)
- **Ponderosa Winery**<sup>RR; v,m,r</sup>, vineyard, truck, house, trees, shop, 3.1 mi <http://www.ponderosawinery.com>

**Sunday afternoon: 1:30: Gilman, Hwy 485** (narrow paved road)

- **gate into parking area**<sup>v,m,c,r,s,p</sup>, sandstone cliffs, open at 1:30, 4 mi
- Gilman tunnels – narrow canyon with stream and steep walls, 5 mi
- Junction of Hwy 4 & 485 – <sup>r,s,p</sup>, narrow bridge, confluence of 2 streams, cottonwoods

**Monday, May 1: Jemez Springs, Hwy 4**

- **\*Legion Drive, Madonna Hall parking lot**<sup>v,m,r,c</sup> 17.4 mi
- **Jemez Fine Art Gallery**<sup>RR; v,m,c</sup> 17.3 mi
- **Our Lady of the Assumption grounds and Presbyterian Cemetery**<sup>v,m,r,c</sup> 17.4 mi
- Community Park<sup>[RR]; v,m,r</sup>, Covered area, large parking area, 17.1 mi
- Jemez Springs Village Park<sup>[RR],F;m,c,s</sup>, Hot spring, Historic Bath House, gazebo, 17.6 mi

- Soda Dam <sup>m,c,s,r</sup> 19 mi

There are many rest stop/fishing access along highway 4 – <sup>v,m,c,r,s</sup>  
cottonwood, juniper, cacti

Rest stops with restrooms are at mm 13.9, and 13.1 (Vista Linda campground).  
Convenience stores with customer's restrooms are at mm 7 and 11.

**Tuesday, May 2: \*Jemez Historic Site** <sup>v,m,c,r</sup> - 8 am - 5 pm, Hwy 4, 18.1 mi

- \*Meet at 8 to park at site, additional parking across street.

[Website](#). Private access to trails through ruins, kiva, museum  
and restrooms. Jemez National Historic Landmark is one of the most beautiful  
prehistoric and historic sites in the Southwest. It includes the stone ruins of a  
500 year old Indian village and the San José de los Jemez church dating to  
1621/2.

**Wednesday, May 3: La Cueva** (and Battleship Rock, Valles Caldera, Fenton  
Lake)

- \***La Cueva Lodge** <sup>CS,F; v,s,p</sup>, fire pit area to gather in evening, junction of  
Highways 4 and 126
- Battleship Rock <sup>[RR]; r,s</sup> – entrance fee \$5/car or free roadside parking  
lot, 23 mi
- La Cueva Picnic Ground <sup>c,r,s</sup> – Rio San Antonio, 26 mi

From La Cueva:

- Take Hwy 4 to point at **Valles Caldera** (13 mi), and other roadside  
parking areas along the way such as Jemez Canyon Overlook, East Fork,  
Jemez Falls, etc.
- Take Hwy 126 to point at **Fenton Lake** (8 mi).
